

Limud Sefer Hamitzvos

There is no need to elaborate on how much it means to the Rebbe that every man, woman and child study the daily portion of the Rambam.

To help show our children the value of the Rebbe's instructions, Tzivos Hashem has prepared a series of workbooks, explaining each Mitzvah, its source in the Torah, as well as the reason for the Mitzvah.

The 613 mitzvahs are to be completed over a 4 year period, from 5th through 8th grade, by learning approximately 150 mitzvahs per year.

Most of the schools have made this Limud a regular school subject, the same as learning Chumash, Halacha and Mishna.

It is our sincere hope that this Limud will ensure that each child in our care will have a clear understanding of all 613 Mitzvahs of the Torah as enumerated by the Rambam, so that for the rest of their lives, when they study the daily shiur of Rambam, they will be able to comprehend it properly.

Limud Schedule 5767

This year we are learning the first 4 seforim of the Rambam: Mada, Ahava, Zemanim & Noshim.

We will be learning an average of six Mitzvos a week, and it is estimated to take approximately 15 minutes a mitzvah.

You will need a total of 1 and half hours a week in your schedule for this subject.

Student's Textbooks

The students workbooks explain each Mitzvah, its source in the Torah, as well as a number of details regarding the Mitzvah. There are also review questions for **homework** to ensure that the students master the material.

Teachers Guide

In addition to the students workbook, we have published a teachers guide, that will: **A.** Elaborate on each mitzvah giving the teachers the additional background to help teach the mitzvah. **B.** Help with pointers of ways to teach each mitzvah.

Biweekly Tests

We will be providing biweekly test for teachers to give to their children. These tests are to be given as all school tests with marks applied to school report cards, etc.

Grand Tests & Grand Prizes

We will be making three grand tests at the the end of the Limmud of Sefer Maddah.

For each tests the child receives a passing mark* they will receive a raffle ticket in the Sefer Hamitzvos Grand Raffle!

These raffles will work in the same way as the World Wide Tehillim Club. More details will come with the curriculum.
